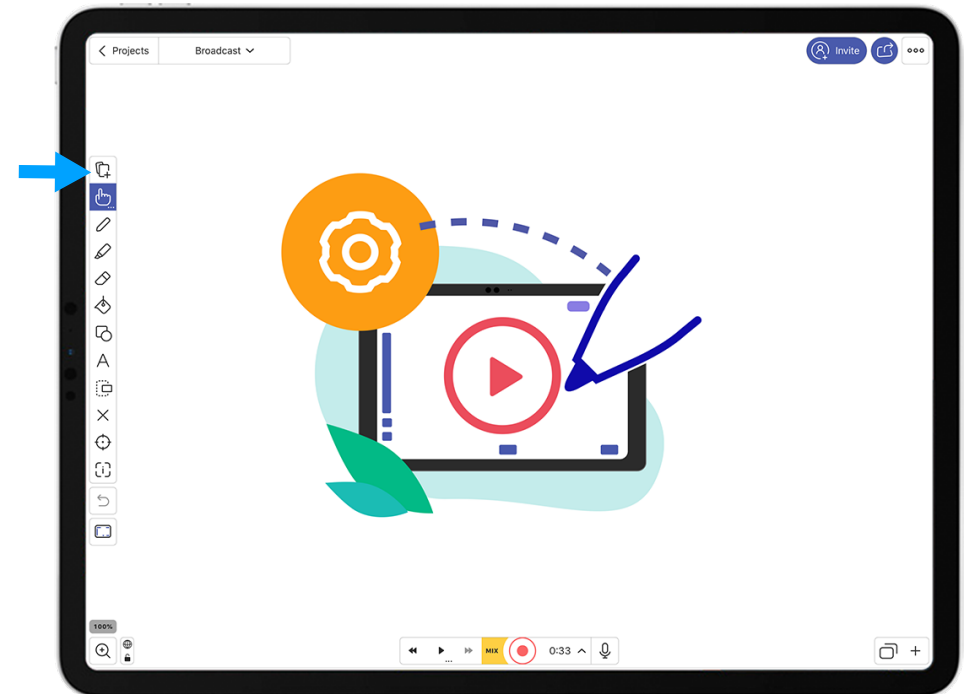


Live broadcast with your whiteboard

- STEP 1**  **Start** your project.
- STEP 2**  **Prepare** your materials (pdfs, book screenshots, photos etc). Put them all on a whiteboard.
-  **Move** and organize every media object using the Hand Tool.
- STEP 3** Start the live conferencing session by **opening your preferred app** such as Zoom, Teams etc. Then tap **Share Screen** and open Explain Everything. This allows your participants to see your content in real-time.

Engage your students or colleagues through **online, real-time connection**. Make it more personal and real. **Always stay on the same page.**

In this scenario, the teacher or presenter broadcasts their whiteboard using a video conferencing solution (e.g. [Zoom](#), [WebEx](#), [Teams](#), [Skype](#), [Google Hangouts Meet](#)).



Good to know

Broadcasting a whiteboard via tablet cuts off your camera. If you still want to be visible, use two devices: one for transmitting your whiteboard and another for transmitting your video.

Share whiteboard videos with anyone in your virtual classroom

STEP 1

Start a project. **Add** your ready-made materials or slides.



STEP 2

Press record to capture your message through audio voice over. Move your materials, highlight the most important parts or simply write things down. Your video is being recorded in real-time.

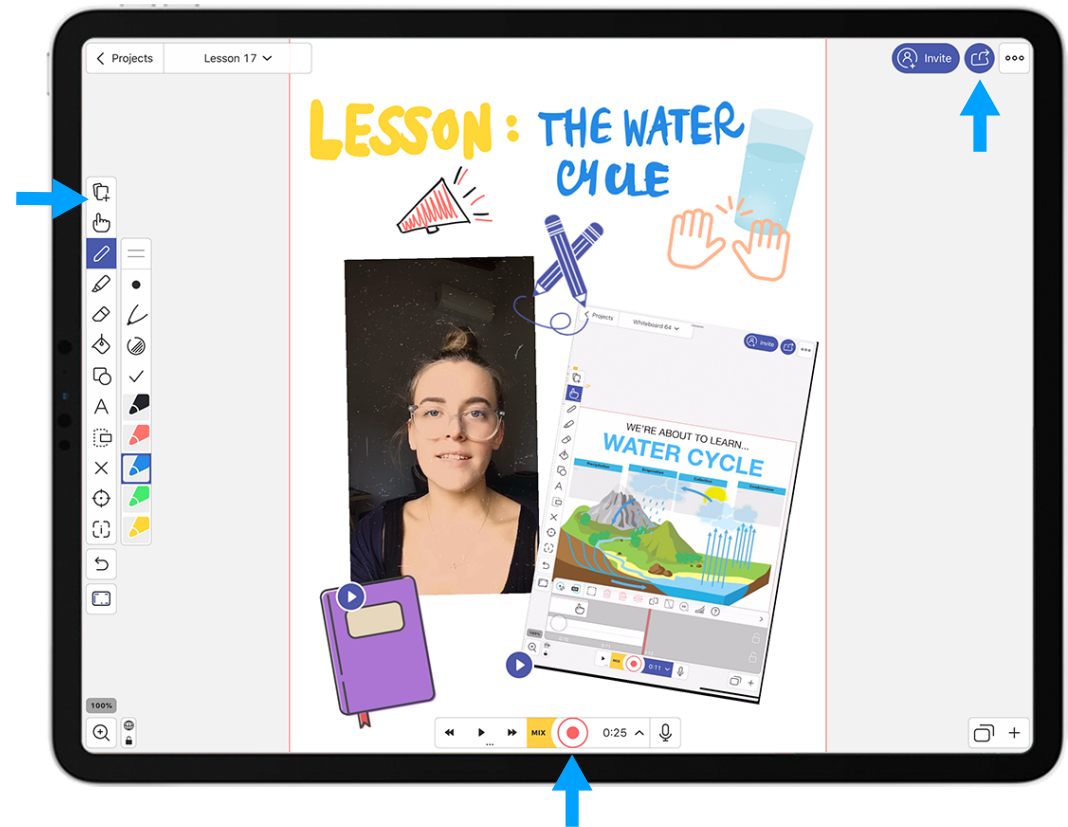


STEP 3

Export your project using web video link, then publish the link to your LMS/CMS or via social networks.



Record simple **explainer videos** to present your point of view using audio, and visuals. There is no better way to **enhance remote communication and assignment**.





Collaborative whiteboarding for better understanding

STEP 1

Tap **Invite** to share the access link to your cloud project with others.



STEP 2

Invite collaborators through email, a web link or simply a CODE. Choose your favorite way and get started!

STEP 3

Once you've added participants, press **Start** to run your first collaboration-based project. You will see all the collaborators listed on the right side of the whiteboard.

Make your lessons more meaningful thanks to **real-time collaboration**. Work together on different projects with your students to increase student learning and achievement. Make it all happen, **no matter the distance**.
